SYNTACTIC STRUCTURES: ESSENCE, TYPES, AND STUDIES IN GLOBAL LINGUISTICS

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Annotation. This article examines the concept of syntactic structures, their linguistic essence, classification, and the major approaches to their study in global linguistics. Syntax occupies a central position in linguistic theory because it explains how words combine to form meaningful phrases, clauses, and sentences. СИНТАКСИЧЕСКИЕ СТРУКТУРЫ: СУЩНОСТЬ, ТИПЫ И ИССЛЕДОВАНИЯ В МИРОВОЙ ЛИНГВИСТИКЕ

Аннотация. В данной статье рассматривается понятие синтаксических структур, их лингвистическая сущность, классификация и основные подходы к их изучению в мировой лингвистике. Синтаксис занимает центральное место в лингвистической теории, поскольку объясняет, каким образом слова объединяются в осмысленные словосочетания, предложения и сложные синтаксические конструкции. SINTAKTIK TUZILMALAR: MOHIYATI, TURLARI VA JAHON TILSHUNOSLIGIDAGI TADQIQOTLAR

Annotatsiya. Mazkur maqolada sintaktik tuzilmalar tushunchasi, ularning lingvistik mohiyati, tasnifi hamda jahon tilshunosligida o'rganilishining asosiy yondashuvlari ko'rib chiqiladi. Sintaksis lingvistik nazariyada markaziy o'rin egallaydi, chunki u so'zlarning qanday qilib mazmunli so'z birikmalari, gaplar va murakkab sintaktik konstruksiyalarga birlashishini izohlaydi. Tadqiqotda sintaksisni o'rganishning an'anaviy, struktur, generativ, funksional va kognitiv yondashuvlari hamda ularning zamonaviy tilshunoslik taraqqiyotiga qo'shgan hissi tahlil qilinadi. Alohida e'tibor sintaktik tuzilmalar tasnifiga, jumladan, sodda, qo'shma, ergash gapli va aralash konstruksiyalarga qaratilgan. The term "syntax" originates from the Greek word *syntaxis*, meaning "arrangement" or "ordering." Syntax investigates the rules governing the combination of words into phrases, clauses, and sentences. These combinations, known as syntactic structures, form the backbone of communication. Without syntactic organization, language would consist merely of isolated words lacking coherent meaning. The significance of syntactic structures extends beyond theoretical linguistics. They play a vital role in language acquisition, translation studies, computational linguistics, natural language processing, discourse analysis, and language education. Consequently, syntax has become one of the most extensively researched domains within modern linguistics.

Throughout history, scholars have proposed different approaches to syntactic analysis. Traditional grammar focused primarily on sentence parts and grammatical categories. Structural linguistics emphasized formal relationships among linguistic units. Generative linguistics introduced the concept of underlying structures and transformational rules. Functional and cognitive linguistics shifted attention toward meaning, communication, and mental processes.

The present study aims to explore the essence of syntactic structures, classify their major types, and examine how they have been investigated in world linguistics.

A syntactic structure is an organized arrangement of linguistic units that forms a meaningful grammatical construction. These units may include words, phrases, clauses, and sentences. The primary function of syntax is to establish relationships among linguistic elements.

For example:

- The student reads a book.
- A book reads the student.

Both sentences contain the same lexical items; however, their syntactic organization differs, resulting in different meanings.

Syntactic structures exhibit several key characteristics:

1. Hierarchical organization
2. Grammatical relationships
3. Semantic coherence
4. Communicative functionality
5. Rule-governed formation

These characteristics demonstrate that syntax is not merely about word order but also about the relationships among linguistic elements.

The study of syntax has a long history extending from ancient grammatical traditions to contemporary linguistic theories.

Syntactic structures can be classified according to their complexity and organizational principles.

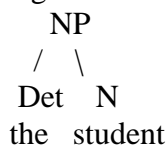
Phrase Structures

A phrase is a group of words functioning as a single unit.

Examples:

- noun phrase (NP): *the talented student*
- verb phrase (VP): *is reading carefully*
- adjective phrase (AdjP): *very intelligent*
- adverb phrase (AdvP): *quite slowly*

Phrase structures are fundamental components of sentence formation.

Clause Structures

A clause contains a subject and a predicate.

Examples:

- She studies.
- They arrived yesterday.

Clauses may be:

- Independent
- Dependent
- Relative
- Adverbial
- Complement clauses

Structural linguistics emerged during the early twentieth century and emphasized language as a system of interconnected elements.

Ferdinand de Saussure introduced the distinction between:

- *Langue* (language system)
- *Parole* (language use)

Structuralists viewed syntactic structures as patterns that could be described objectively through distributional analysis. Leonard Bloomfield further developed structural methods by emphasizing observable linguistic forms rather than psychological interpretations.

Structural syntax contributed significantly to linguistic methodology by establishing rigorous descriptive procedures.

Cognitive linguistics emerged in the late twentieth century as a response to purely formal approaches. Major scholars include:

- Ronald Langacker
- George Lakoff
- Leonard Talmy

Cognitive linguists argue that syntactic structures reflect conceptual organization and mental processes.

For example, sentence constructions often reveal how speakers perceive events, participants, and relationships.

The cognitive approach emphasizes:

- Meaning construction
- Conceptualization
- Categorization
- Embodied cognition

Thus, syntax is viewed as an integral component of human cognition rather than an autonomous system.

Recent developments indicate several important research directions:

1. Corpus-based syntax
2. Cognitive syntax
3. Construction grammar
4. Computational parsing
5. Artificial intelligence and language modeling
6. Multimodal discourse analysis
7. Cross-linguistic syntactic comparison

Researchers increasingly combine qualitative and quantitative methods to investigate syntactic phenomena. These trends reflect the interdisciplinary nature of contemporary linguistic inquiry.
