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


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## THE EFFECT OF THE INTERNET ON THE FORMATION OF SOCIAL CONSCIOUSNESS OF YOUTH



#### **ABSTRACT**

This article emphasizes the importance of educating our youth to be independent, able to stand up to various spiritual information attacks, to be selfless and patriotic. the priorities of effective and reliable protection from ideas and influences are elaborated. And in today's increasingly information-intensive, diverse media sources and media, there is a sharp struggle to capture the minds of young people. In addition, the positive and negative aspects of the impact on the social consciousness of young people through the Internet and the media were analyzed.

#### INTRODUCTION AND RELEVANCE.

The new generation, which is entering an independent life, is brought up under the influence of the ideas existing in the society, absorbing certain views and ideas into its beliefs. 60% of the population of our country are young people aged 14 to 30. Modern conditions and opportunities have been created for them to get an education and acquire a profession. At the same time, the organization of meaningful leisure of young people is a topical issue. The more spiritually mature young people are, the stronger their immunity against various alien vices will be. It is known that the head of our state Sh. M. Mirziyoyev brings forward that it is important to put into practice 5 important initiatives in order to organize work in the social, spiritual and educational spheres on the basis of a new system. The third initiative is aimed at organizing the effective use of computer technology and the Internet among the population and youth. Anyone can receive or transmit any information through the Internet, which surrounds the minds of young people like a network. Nowadays, humanity is calling the twenty-first century as the "information age."

Today, information technology is rapidly evolving and information spaces are gaining global reach. In particular, the development of the Internet ensures that information of any content overcomes various barriers and reaches consumers. "Some experts are comparing the flow of information that has been pounced at humanity today to Noah's flood," he said. This second "flood" in the history of mankind can have even more devastating consequences than the previous one. Because it is an invisible "flood" that ignores any obstacle [1]. In recent years, the Internet, which is the world's message to meet the needs of the human child by his thirst for innovation and information,

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has led to many positive and negative consequences. The Internet is not subject to the laws of any state and is not accountable to anyone for its activities. In the new information space, data is placed in very large volumes and spreads at lightning speed. Of course, it has a significant impact on the expansion of the social consciousness, worldview, and knowledge of youth.

In the context of the Internet, state borders remain open. Of course, every country tries to protect its borders as much as possible. But in this regard, we believe that a reliable way is to create immunity of the general population to information that is contrary to the national traditions and interests of Uzbekistan. If a citizen who browses the Internet has a strong sense of homeland, strong faith in his people, does not believe in any lies and fabrications, has immunity, strong faith, high pride, political culture cannot be influenced by alien ideas. The first President of the Republic of Uzbekistan I. A. Karimov noted, "Today, our young people receive a wide range of information not only in educational institutions, but also through radio and television, the press and the Internet. In such a situation, when the world information space is expanding, it is necessary to educate our children not only to read it, but also to see it, to surround them with an iron wall, which is undoubtedly in line with the requirements of the time and our noble goals are considered to be those." [2].

#### RESEARCH METHODS.

Today, tools that serve to influence people through information have become a means to achieve strategic superiority. Scientists now consider information to be an influence on the minds and hearts of people through an information tool (means of transmitting, processing, creating and receiving information that was previously directed to a specific goal) [3]. The modern urban citizen receives information mainly from the media, artificially "molded" by experts. One watches TV, listens to the news, watches movies and plays with specific goals in his screenplays, and listens to music. He also scans more than a thousand words that have been edited by someone every day.

The World Wide Web is a public area where many social actors interact, which means that it makes it possible to ensure interethnic and intercultural interaction on a large scale[4.]Those who propagate ideas that are alien to our spirituality through the Internet and social media try to achieve their goals, mainly by influencing the emotions of young people. The fact that some older, life-experienced parents are indifferent to their children, imitating the negative aspects of Western behavior in clothing, behavior, relationships, dreams and aspirations, and sometimes encourage them, causes serious problems in the upbringing of the next generation. Today, "Mass culture" also has a great impact on the minds of our youth. In this regard, it is necessary to pay attention to the opinion of the President of Uzbekistan, Sh. Mirziyoyev: "We must never forget one thing. If we say that the threat of "mass culture" comes only from abroad - from the West, we are seriously mistaken. This calamity, unfortunately, can come from ourselves, from among ourselves. I am not saying this lightly. It is natural for any sane person to come to such a conclusion after watching some newspapers and magazines, books, some music videos and movies, songs and dances [5]. The fact that we sometimes encounter those who unknowingly invade our spirituality proves the need for education as well as the search for knowledge from the cradle to the grave.

The 21st century, as an age of intellectual potential, thinking and spirituality, is opening up new horizons for humanity, as well as bringing about acute problems that we have never seen or encountered before. In such a complex and dangerous time, the warm, touching words of free-thinking people, first of all spiritual devotees, calling our people, including our youth, to goodness, honesty, kindness and tolerance are becoming more important than ever. «49% of e-games played by young people on Internet clubs look significantly violent and vicious, while 41% of militant games (based on various shootings and explosions) use violence and evil to achieve their goals» [6]. Such games can be compared to a fire thrown at the minds of young people, because such games poison the minds of young people and negatively affect their spiritual upbringing. Another noteworthy fact is that today the number of pornographic sites on the Internet is 4.2 million, the number of such pages has exceeded 420 million. It is horrible that the majority of visitors to these sites are 12-17 year olds. In places where there are no Internet cables in the country, young people are using the abovementioned disadvantages with the help of mobile phones.



#### RESEARCH RESULTS.

It should be noted that today, social networks, which play an important role in the formation of social opinion, cover almost the entire world. Youth activism is particularly evident in these sectors, but the analysis of the pros and cons of this process is becoming increasingly complex. Of course, the forums and discussions on various topics in these areas are becoming a significant issue in terms of their impact on the morale of young people. In this regard, let's pay attention to the views of the President of Uzbekistan Sh. Mirziyoyev in this regard: "... the lives, thoughts, dreams and, most importantly, the issues that afflict young people, unfortunately, are not fully reflected in radio and television, newspapers and magazines. As if everything is in its place, the world is beautiful. If everything is in its place, where do misguided young people, crime, unemployment come from? Why don't the media, especially the youth press, talk about officials who are indifferent to the state youth policy? [7].

One way or another, many Western authors agree that globalization has a direct and strong impact on the lives of young people, since it leads to an accelerated social division, the victims of which are young people in the first place. As a result, the status of youth is fundamentally changing, and, therefore, the youth policy pursued by the state must also change. [8]. Today, young people are increasing their experience and confidence in life by participating in community life[9].

Modern life requires awareness of events. However, just as everything has its own measure, the norm, it is good that we receive information only in the amount we need, to the extent that it benefits us, not harms us. Mobile communication, Internet blogs and social networks have made it possible for everyone to receive, distribute information and express their opinions freely. At the same time, people can easily access information about what they are doing, what color clothes they like the most, and so on through the Internet. There are those who spend their precious time reading such «confessions». Even those who «occupy» their memory with lyrics, SMS-messages, phone numbers. Information can serve different purposes. It all depends on who uses it and how.

Today, let's talk about mobile devices, which are one of the real threats to the spirituality of our people. It is impossible to imagine our lives today without mobile devices, but no matter how much information is spread through the media about its harm to human health, it cannot be said that we are declining in the use of these tools. I think the young people are the ones who suffer the most from these tools today. Because our young people who use modern phones have the opportunity to post all kinds of movies, clips, obscene pictures on them. The Internet is disturbing the world community with its pornographic sites, affecting the minds of teenagers and spreading some unconventional messages. According to a study by Belgian professor Frank Tevisson, 90 percent of students in European countries use the Internet. However, when surveyed on which site they use, it was found that only 10 percent of students preferred access to sites directly related to the learning process, and 90 percent preferred access to sites with pornographic content [10].

The negative aspects of the globalization process have also shifted to mobile communication, which is having an impact on young people, especially adolescents. The obscene, violent posters that some are trying to popularize through such phones will inevitably have a negative impact on the psyche and spirituality of young people. Unfortunately, some parents are indifferent to this. Studies show that some families are also divorced due to misinformation and messages spread over the phones. In the fight against such negative phenomena, first of all, it is important to form in young people a high morale and national immunity, a culture of telephone use.

Given the harmful effects of computers, the negative impact of the internet on human health is greater than that of a normal book. A number of Russian doctors who have studied this situation have listed the negative effects of computers on human health. In particular, sitting in front of a computer for a long time has a negative effect on a person's spine and causes various diseases, together with exposure to electromagnetic radiation from the monitor, impaired vision, fatigue of the finger joints, loss of information can cause stress. Although these factors are not directly related to the Internet, but because of the computer being one of its essentials, working on the Internet for a long time can gradually have a negative impact on human health. Reading a book, on the other hand, avoids these negative effects. The book also has many more benefits than electronic publications.

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Therefore, the book is the best tool to have all the information about world culture and history, art, as well as various fields.

That the Internet, created primarily as a means of free communication, in just a few decades has become the most important technology that reflects all the variety of forms of organization of society[11]. Anyone who works on the internet is aware of world news, however, some young people do not feel that they are in a virtual world. Working in it can also be detrimental to the development and health of mental ideas. That is why it is advisable for parents to monitor how their children are using the Internet. Nowadays, various Internet sites have a negative impact on the minds of young people, but the number of people who get used to it is increasing day by day. Such a mental connection leads to tragic consequences. Some young people are involved in various games in computer clubs. It exists not only in Uzbekistan but also in other countries. For example, computer games are very popular in South Korea. We can't say that bullying games, which do not fit into our mentality and sometimes turn into heroic savagery, can have a positive impact on the moral and aesthetic upbringing of our children found [12].

Much of the information prepared for Central Asian countries is funded by ideological centers that aim to have a psychological impact on the worldview of those living in the region. Their aim is to assimilate the wrong path chosen by the independent states, with the main focus on justifying that they will ultimately face social upheavals, all of which are being done to demoralize the nation, turn it back from its chosen path and force it to seek patronage. If our national press is weak, if the climate in the media is determined by others, we will lose the information war, which will be for the forces that want to influence our country with such nonsense as «freedom» and «democracy». We all know that this cannot be allowed. Therefore, as the head of our state said, it would be expedient to fight against thought with a thought, against idea after idea, against ignorance with enlightenment. The processes of post-industrial revolution, informatization, and globalization have created individuals who pursue profit, who seek to satisfy their material interests and needs, who have lost their national and class image, and who are ready to use any idea for their own ends. Such negative situations will affect our country as well. It is necessary to fight against this, to use all possible means.

It is clear that nowadays any information has no boundaries, so maintaining the inviolability of the spiritual world of the young generation, whose consciousness and worldview is being formed, is a common problem. «It is in this context,» says the pamphlet «The Idea of National Independence: Basic Concepts and Principles,» that it is natural that ideas that are alien to the noble goals of the people and the state should try to influence society. Especially where ideological instability prevails, the ideological threat increases. Attempts to capture the consciousness of the general population, especially young people, are on the rise [13]. The first President of the Republic of Uzbekistan Islam Karimov touched upon the following issue: "... in order to prevent any disease, first of all, the human body develops immunity against it. We also need to establish a healthy attitude to the motherland in the hearts of our children, our rich history, the sacred religion of our ancestors, to strengthen their ideological immunity, so to speak. So that they become people with strong national roots, a deep understanding of the world, who keep pace with the times. Then he said, «Even the 'call' of an ignorant fanatic rejects morality, and even ideas that are completely foreign to us cannot affect them»[14]. Restricting the Internet or stopping access to data will not solve the problem.

Our President Sh. Mirziyoyev instructed the Ministry of Information Technologies and Communications to establish Digital Technology Training Centers in all cities and district centers on the basis of best international practices. These centers provide free training in e-commerce and programming, develop innovative business skills in the field of information technology, support for «startup» projects.

Today, despite the fact that all schools have computer equipment, it is clear that the Internet service is not used enough. On these issues, the head of state instructed the Ministry of Public Education and the Ministry of Information Technologies and Communications to develop an action plan to provide computer classrooms in all schools with modern technologies and high-speed Internet by 2021. The goal is to establish computer game centers with the involvement of enterprising



entrepreneurs, which should have tests, quizzes, development strategies and other useful programs that will serve to expand the knowledge and outlook of children and youth. Given the positive and negative effects of the media on the social consciousness of young people, it can be said that the role of the information environment in the spiritual development of a person is great.

The availability and magnitude of the opportunity to share information gives us ample opportunities, while at the same time calling people to awareness. On social networks such as Odnoklassniki, Facebook, Twitter, YouTube, which are currently used by our young people, we often see young people arguing about something - books, photos, movies, songs. Of course, the exchange of ideas sharpens the mind, strengthens thinking. But we must not forget that the repercussions of some socially dangerous information can create even more dangerous scenes.

#### **CONCLUSION.**

In general, in order to solve the above problems, the educational process is structured and expects quality sources of information (including the Internet, multimedia, electronic textbooks) and, of course, a natural and legitimate process. If information and communication technologies are used effectively and systematically in education, the quality and efficiency of education will naturally increase if the new generation of textbooks, manuals and tools for educational institutions are regularly introduced.

The study and deep understanding of the rich, spiritual heritage of our ancestors will lead them to perfection. Their knowledge of the world through the Internet will help them to increase their intellectual potential. In this sense, the heirs of a country that values its past and faces the future, as well as its past, will introduce the great country to the world.

From restoring a person's health to improving their welfare, enriching their spirituality with information, and other areas, important points can be made. But there are concepts in the human heart and mind that cannot be replaced by anything. When a combination of pedagogical technology, parental example, heritage of generations, strong will, integrity of faith in the concepts of patriotism, national pride, self-awareness, pride of the country, a person strives for perfection. The Internet, like any science breakthrough, has its pros and cons. There is no need to justify the growing role and importance of the global network in our lives, how important it is for humanity. It is also natural for international terrorist and extremist organizations to try to exert their influence through the virtual world. Better results would be achieved only when all states acted together, recognizing the threat of terrorism, the tragic global threat to international, regional and national security and stability, and humanity in general.
